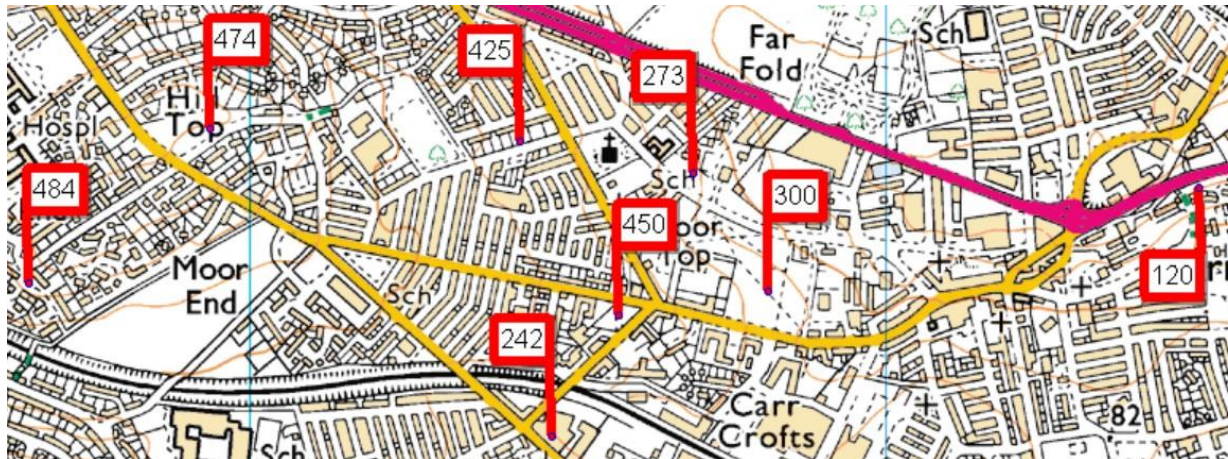


Modern location of 'Privilege' tenter sites from Armley and Wortley Inclosure Awards.

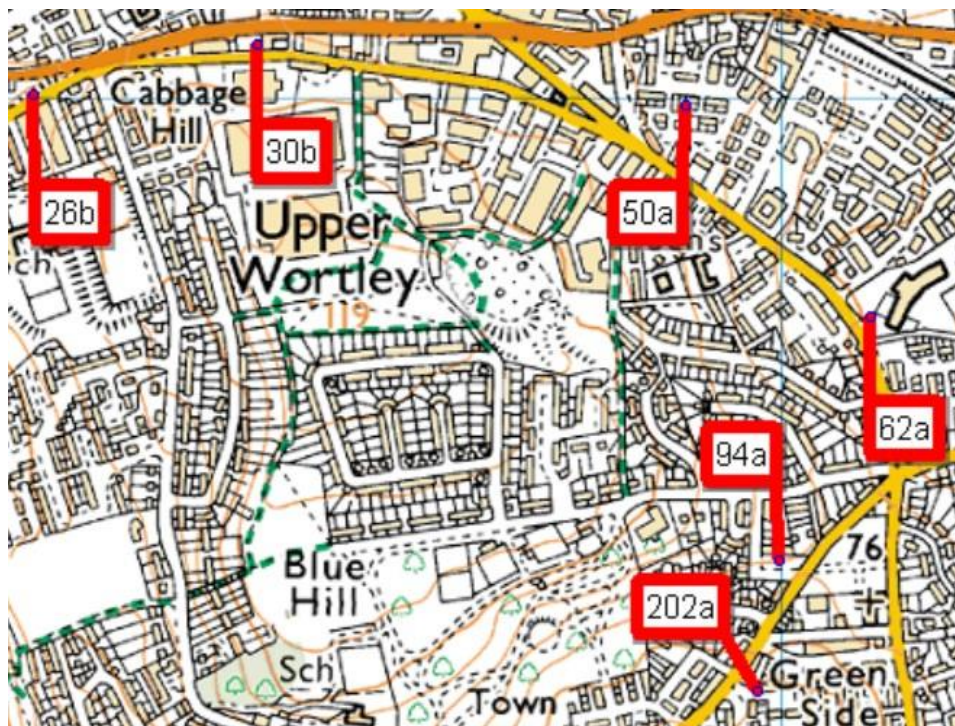
Armley (Inclosure Award 1799):

'...using of Tenters, stretchers for Warp Wool, Hedges for the spreading and drying of wool or for any other use'.



Wortley (Inclosure Award 1847):

'...tentering Woollen Cloths, drying Webs and spreading Pieces thereon and for other such Uses and Purposes.



The identifiers are the plot numbers from the respective Tithe apportionments (1845 and 1846).
